Tickets (15) 2004
Dir: Ken Loach & others 115 mins

A portmanteau of three short films all set on the same train heading for Rome. An enjoyable, well-observed movie, the three directors compare and contrast the effects of wealth and privilege for people taking the same journey for very different reasons.

15th April 2008

Ivan's Childhood 1962
Dir: Andrei Tarkovsky 97 mins

Ivan is 12 years old, and is determined to avenge the deaths of his family at the hands of the Nazis by spying for the Russians, all the way to Berlin. Great photography, powerful and moving, Tarkovsky's first feature won Best Picture at the Venice Film Festival in 1962.

22nd april 2008

Famiglia Rodante (15) 2004
Dir: Pablo Trapero 103 mins

An 84-year-old widow persuades 12 members of her extended family to drive with her the length of the country to attend a wedding in the hometown she hasn't visited since her teenage years. A funny, heartwarming experience.

This is England (18) 2006
Dir: Shane Meadows 100 mins

A lonely, fatherless boy gets sucked into the skinhead movement of the early 1980s. Semi autobiographical, this sad, painful and sometimes funny story is the latest episode in Shane Meadows' honest, increasingly accomplished (but never polished), always abrasive tales from England's working classes.
Some swearing and racist themes.
